Lakefront Comfort Stations by Muller & Muller Ltd.

The Lakefront Comfort Stations are an amazing example of how a building can live in harmony with its environment. Constructed to provide basic public facilities for beach users, these buildings harvest rain water for use in flushing toilets, are vented and cooled naturally by lake breezes, and are 100% naturally day lit through the use of solar skylight tubes. And all of these amazing features could not have been brought together without the commitment at Muller & Muller to push for changes to state and local building codes. Thank you for taking environmentally innovative technologies to the next level while also paving the way for others to follow in your footsteps.

Nature Boardwalk at Lincoln Park Zoo

The Nature Boardwalk is the former south pond of Lincoln Park Zoo, transformed into a 14-acre haven for native animals and plants. The former pond drew over one million gallons of fresh water per month to keep the pollution from waterfowl waste and wild birds at a safe level. As the Nature Boardwalk, fresh water usage has been reduced by 75% through the use of natural water-filtering vegetation! Thank you Lincoln Park Zoo for bringing Chicago such a beautiful example of sustainability.

Sankofa House by Harley Ellis Devereaux

This partnership between the Life Enhancement Studio at Harley Ellis Devereaux and the Interfaith Housing Development Corporation has resulted in 58 units of affordable, sustainable housing for two at-risk populations in Chicago's North Lawndale neighborhood: kinship families and young adults aging out of foster care. The Sankofa House meets the needs of its intergenerational residents by encouraging independence among young adults, family strength among the kinship families, and community for everyone. The sustainable features include roof mounted wind turbines, day lit shared living rooms, low flow plumbing fixtures, and two vegetative roof gardens.

The CNT Energy Savers Program offers a one-stop shop that helps multifamily building owners in the Chicago region improve energy efficiency and reduce operating costs. From finding the most cost-effective energy-saving investments, to obtaining low-cost financing, overseeing construction, and ensuring reliable results, Energy Savers delivers building-specific solutions and proven results. Participating building owners have reduced energy costs by nearly 30% on average.

CNT Energy Director Anne Evens performed the Energy Savers Fast Pitch presentation. On the audience choice ballots, voters were asked to write in their reasons for their choice. The most common reason by far for choosing CNT Energy Savers was the feeling that this brought the greatest impact to the Chicago region.
